PATROL RULES

PATROL DUTIES OF ACTIVE MEMBERS: Every Active Member shall be bound by and submit to rules and duties as shown on Roster Card.

1. Every Active Member must be financial and complete a test swim within six weeks of the start of each season. Seniors and Juniors 440 yards in still water in nine minutes.
2. Every Active Member must compete and complete the course in at least one swimming event each month during the season commencing 1st December to 31st March.
3. Every Active Member must compete and complete every position in a Bronze Medallion team and at least have one row in surf boat.
4. RULES FOR THE GUIDANCE OF PATROLS :
 - (1) The beach shall be patrolled by members of the Club during the season on Saturday afternoon, Sunday and Public Holidays.
 - (2) Patrol Captains are held responsible for the efficiency of their patrol. On the completion of each patrol they are required to immediately record a full report on their patrol card and hand same to the Club Captain or Vice Captain.

The undermentioned information must be included:

 - (a) The time of arrival and departure of each member of the patrol. Members are not on duty if not in costume.
 - (b) Details of all rescues performed.
 - (c) Names of absentees, leave granted, substitutes and time absent from duty.
 - (d) Details of any special happening during patrol.

- (3) No member of the patrol shall leave the patrol area during his period of duty without first obtaining the Patrol Captain's permission.
- (4) Every member on patrol must wear in the proper manner the regulation cap of red and gold, supplied by the Club, at all times.
- (5) Members of the public are not permitted to enter the patrol enclosure.
- (6) The patrol shall see that all life-saving gear is placed in position on the beach at the commencement of patrol and that it is all returned to the gear room at the completion.
- (7) The Patrol Captains shall be responsible for the return of caps and whistles to the Club Captain on the completion of patrol duty.
- (8) See Rule 30, Clause (f).
- (9) The names of members missing patrols shall be placed on the notice board, members missing 9 hours patrol shall have membership automatically terminated.
- (10) Each member shall see that his name and time of duty is correctly entered on patrol attendance card.
- (11) Any member failing to carry out Patrol Duties satisfactorily shall be reported by his Patrol Captain to the Club Vice-Captain, who shall refer it to the Club Management Committee for action to be taken in accordance with the Club Constitution.
